1. Introduction

3. Annual meeting (annual reports and plans on website)

This is our fourth annual meeting. The procedures for the annual meeting are defined in the bylaws. The invitation was sent out four weeks before the meeting and there were no addidtional topics asked for by the members. The annual report 2014, the long term plan 2015-2019 and the action plan 2015 as documented on the website was accepted by all the members.

The new **member fees** as reported on the website and documented in the attachment **was accepted** by all members. There was a discussion about the memberships of Universities and higher education institutions. There is already an agreement between the SI and these institutions and this issue will have to be reviewed (Meyer).

The **budget** as attached **was accepted** by all the members.

Every two years the **managment team** has to be confirmed, this year is an election year. Marcel Ledergerber, Knud Niebur and Niklaus Meyer agreed to stay in the management team. Beat Koch and Doris Slezak, who were part of the team since the start of the Green IT SIG in 2010, have asked to step down because of too much pressure at work. They will continue as members of the team and will be active in the EnergieSchweiz data center project, in the EU Green IT task force, in the education specialty team and assist in other functions. Beat and Doris were instrumental in the set up of the Green IT SIG, in particular by bringing in the actions catalogue they developed previously. We are glad that they continue to support us. Many thanks to Beat and Doris for all their contributions.

Jérôme Kolly, who was representing the Green IT development in la Suisse Romande following Chritian Blumer, asked to step down as well, he and his wife have busy days with the recent birth of twins and Jérôme is building up his own company. Many thanks Jérôme for supporting the Green IT cause in the recent months.

Ruzica Dimova and Christian Marchand have agreed to join the Management Team. Ruzica wrote her bachelor thesis about Green IT including the Green Data Center Assessment function. In addition to being a member of the management team she will also lead the web development team. Christian Marchand was instrumental in founding the Green IT Antenne Romande and is developing together with Bernhard Hämmerli the MAS Energy informatics course, including the CAS Green IT. Welcome Ruzica and Christian in the Management Team.

The members of the new management team are: Niklaus Meyer (president), Ruzica Dimova (web development), Marcel Ledergerber and Knud Niebur (data center), Christian Marchand (Antenne Romande). **The new management team was supported by all the members.**

4. Web Development

2 ½ years ago at the Beatenberg workshop a team of 7 Green IT SIG members started the Green Data Center assessment project. With a number of additional workshops a complete assessment was developed. Ruzica assisted the activity as part of her bachelor work and Beat Koch developed the web application together with an external developer. Marcel Ledergerber was providing in the end a lot of the detail requirements and finally, with the help of Mike Sidorov, a new developer from the Soft-Group company, we could finish the application.

Marcel gave a short demonstration of the features of the applications and the members were impressed by the progress. We will need to define now how we can roll out the application to the benefit of the whole country. In principle we want to address primarily the CIOs and managers of companies with medium size data centers. Knud Niebur was asked to organize a

Attachments

A. Membership fees

The membership contribution is determined by the size of the company.

The contributions in the calendar year 2015 are:

- Large companies (sales > 3 million CHF): CHF 3,000 / year (incl. SI contribution of 260)
- Companies with sales between 500k CHF and 3 million CHF: CHF 750 / year (including SI contribution of 260)
- Small businesses (sales < 500k CHF): CHF 330 / year (including SI contribution of 260)
- Individuals: CHF 150 / year (incl. SI contribution of 80)
- Students: CHF 35 / year (incl. SI contribution of 25)
- Government administration departments (set on a case by case basis)

The contributions are collected by the Office of the Swiss Informatics Society, Effingerstrasse 19, 3008 Bern.

The member companies can delegate several persons to the SIG meetings, present their logo on the greenit.s-i.ch site and request Green IT team members for contributions to internal company events.

B. Budget

1. Introduction

At the beginning of 2015 we have about CHF 9000 on our account. Most of the expenses in 2014 were absorbed by the members themselves. Web development has been postponed to 2015 and about CHF 3000 have already been spent. While up to the beginning of 2015 a good part of the developments have been done by Beat Koch, Marcel Ledergerber and Niklaus Meyer on their own time, it is time to prepare for the period, when these persons are not anymore available. Some members proposed a change such that web development can be supported continuously and an administrative resource hired part time. The right company form and structure to provide Green IT services in Switzerland is a discussion we should hold in 2015. For the time being we consider to fulfill our mission in the form of a SIG of the SI and therefore according to the rules of the SI (SIG members should in general also be SI members).

Income and cost of public conferences will not be listed here, but it is assumed that we have to cover potential deficits of such events.
